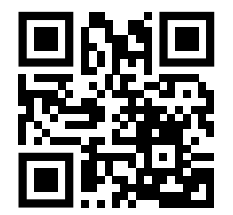
Judges will select three postcards to be mass produced for distribution in national "Get Out The Young Vote" campaigns through 2024.
