ART THE VOTE CONTEST FOR YOUNG ARTISTS

Young Artists Invited to Submit Original Artworks to Encourage Young People to Vote

Asbury Park NJ “Who better than young artists to encourage young voters?” says Jayne Mackta, Art the Vote co-founder. “Our contest invites them to make their best creative case for the importance of registering to vote and for voting in every election. Their vision will amplify the message that young people have the power to make democracy work for all.”

The contest is open to all young artists. There are two divisions: High School and Post-High School (up to age 22). A maximum of two entries can be submitted, digitally, by each artist. The artwork must be original and can include paintings, drawings, cartoons, infographics and photographs.

Digital submissions are due June 15, 2022 at <https://artthevote.org/enter-now/>. There is no entry fee. Notification of acceptance and winners will be announced on July 15, 2022.

Cash prizes will be awarded: \$150 for the winner in both divisions and \$75 for the second place winner in each division. The judges will also select three postcards to be mass produced for “Get Out the Young Vote” campaigns through 2024. Accepted work will be displayed in the virtual exhibition scheduled to launch August 1, 2022.
